 Novice Groups will be run in both morning and afternoon sessions

Two groups run in the morning; two in the afternoon. Entrants must work the event; your work session is the other morning or afternoon group. For example, if you run Group 2, you must work Group 1. Solo event registration opens on site at 8 am. Morning driver's meeting is at 9:15; the afternoon driver's meeting is at 12:15. Be sure to arrive early enough to have your car tech inspected and to walk the course. A Novice group will also be run in the morning and in the afternoon. Run groups may be adjusted on event day to balance run group size; every effort will be made to keep classes in their original morning or afternoon.

Event Descriptions: **Solo** is a competition featuring one car at a time on a course defined by traffic cones (pylons). Top speeds are generally 65 mph or lower. Entry is open to almost all cars that pass a safety inspection. **PDX** (Performance Driving Experience) is held on a road course. It is non-competitive. Speeds are unlimited, passing is controlled, and instruction is required for novices. Entry is open to most cars. **Track Trial** is a competition for best lap time on a road course. Speeds are unlimited, passing is controlled. Track Trials require significant driver and car safety equipment. A **Club Trial** is similar to a Track Trial, but with fewer safety items required and no racing tires allowed. A **Tour** is a group "drive in the country."
