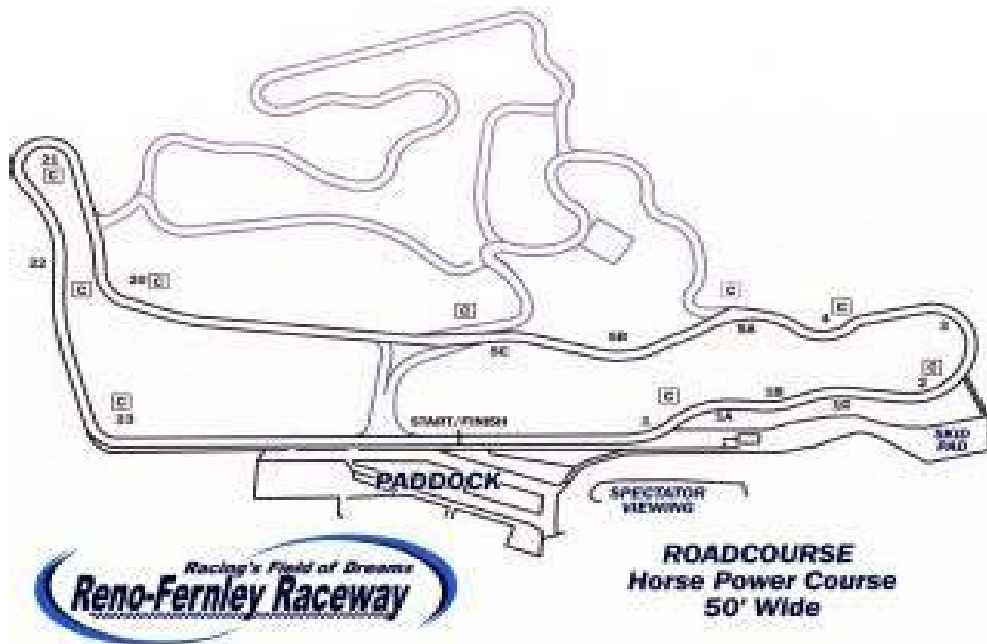
SCCA Road Racing returns to Reno.

Sports Car Club of America road racing will return to Reno at Reno-Fernley Raceway June 14 and 15.

Reno, Nevada February 15, 2008: The Reno Region of the Sports Car Club of America will host the "Charles Schwab Bank, Race-To-Reno" at Reno-Fernley Raceway the weekend of June 14 and 15. The weekend features 7 separate races with over 30 different classes of cars. Practice and qualifying will be held on Saturday, June 14 with the racing beginning on Sunday, June 15 at 10 a.m.

These races are the first SCCA races held in Reno since October 1997. The races will be divided into three groups: National races for all SCCA national classes; regional races featuring IT, Touring, GT, Prepared and Production classes, plus a Vintage open & closed wheel group – VP1, VP2, VP3, and VF5R.

The races will be held at Reno-Fernley Raceway which is 35 miles east of Reno and south of the town of Fernley off of I-80. Reno-Fernley Raceway has also scheduled a practice day on Friday, June 13th. The 2.2 mile Horsepower Course configuration highlighted below will be used for this event.
